



# Health Board Vacancy

(2 vacancies)

**Bay Mills Indian Community Health Board acts as a liaison to the Tribal Governing Board regarding the Health and Human Services System. Each new member is voted in by the current board, with final approval by the Executive Council. The Health Board shall be comprised of seven (7) members, at least five of whom must be Bay Mills Indian Community members. Members of the Health Board shall serve a three (3)-year staggered term, and will be limited to three-consecutive appointments. Members may be reappointed for an additional three consecutive terms, after a full three years off of the Board. This board is open to Non-Tribal members.**

Must meet at least one qualification that follows:

- ❖ Tribal elder (age 55 and above)
- ❖ Current patient of the Bay Mills Health Center
- ❖ Professional or administrative experience in one of the following fields: health, finance, public health, or behavioral health
- ❖ Has prior or current experience as a medical health professional
- ❖ Recognized by the Community as knowledgeable and practicing traditional Anishinaabe culture
  
- ❖ Must **not** be a Bay Mills Health Center Employee

Individuals seeking appointment to the Health Board must submit a written letter of interest stating qualifications, along with at least one (1) letter of support from a Bay Mills Indian Community member or Health Center Employee to PRC at the Bay Mills Health Center, or to the address listed below.
